

5x - 3/4" x 48" x 96" Plywood

1x - 1/4" x 48" x 96" Plywood

2x - 1 x 2 x 6' Common Boards

1-1/4" Wood Screws

1-1/4" Pocket Screws


1-1/4" 18g Brad Nails

Wood Glue

Drawer Pulls


Truck Bed Liner Paint

Stain or Paint as desired




Step 1: Assemble Drawer Box




interior side of all panels smooth and polyurethane as it will be impossible after. Then, drill pocket holes and assemble sides, center, back and bottom using wood glue and 1-1/4" pocket screws.

Then, pre-drill and attach top with wood glue and 1-1/4" wood screws.

Step 2: Assemble Drawers (Qty 2)



Step 3: Assemble Power Crate



Pre-drill and assemble power crate using wood glue and 1-1/4" wood screws.


Fill screw holes with wood filler and sand smooth.

Optional:


Cut 1/4" wide dado, 5/16" deep in the sides and bottom panel as shown.

Cut out handles by drilling two 1-1/4" holes and connect using jigsaw.

(Note: Divider/dado placed to accept Ryobi supercharger)




Step 4: Assemble Drawers (Qty 2)



Cut out handles by drilling two 1-1/4" holes and connect using jigsaw.


Assemble frame using wood glue and 1-1/4" wood screws. Then, glue and nail bottom on using 1-1/4" brad nails.


Step 5: Drawer Fronts & Handles



With drawers in place, locate drawer fronts such that there is an even gap on all sides and attach using wood glue and 1-1/4" brad nails.

From the inside of the drawer screw through and into the drawer front using 1-1/4" wood screws.





Finish the drawer fronts and install drawer pulls as desired.

Step 6: Finish and Install
